

What is the course about and what are the entry requirements?

This course forms part of the Level 2 academic pathway.

What subjects will I study?

Chemistry is the study of materials, their structure and interactions with each other. You will study a range of topics covering organic, inorganic and physical chemistry, including atoms, chemical reactions, the Periodic Table, Metals, Fuels and Polymers.

How will I be assessed?

Three examinations at the end of the course:

- Multiple choice paper (45 mins) worth 30%
- Written exam paper (75 mins) worth 50%
- Alternative to practical exam (60 mins) worth 20%

What are my progression and career options?

Successful completion with satisfactory attendance allows progression to Level 3 study, an apprenticeship or vocational courses. Alternatively, you could seek employment and explore UCM's part-time prospectus for a relevant qualification in your new career.
