

## What is the course about?

This vocational course is equivalent to 3 A Levels for those wishing to find employment in the Island's finance sector or for progression on to a degree in higher education either on or off the Island. The course is a blend of 13 business modules studied over 2 years such as marketing, accounting, law, human resources, event management, all of which are essential in today's workplace. In addition, students have an opportunity to re-take GCSE Maths. The qualification is equivalent to three GCSEs and you will also take either GCSE or Functional Skills in Maths and English during the same academic year.

## What are the entry requirements?

4 GCSEs grade A\* to C, including English and Mathematics at grade C.

## What subjects will I study?

The modules may include:

Exploring Business  
Marketing  
Employment Law  
Recruitment & Selection  
Personal & Business Finance  
Management Accounting  
Creative Promotions

## How will I be assessed?

4 modules are assessed through external examinations, 2 in the first year and 2 in the second year. The remaining modules are assessed through written assessments. These typically include written reports, presentations, booklets, information leaflets and group work activities.

## What are my progression and career options?

Higher Education – this qualification attracts UCAS points allowing you to progress to studying a degree either on the Island or off Island.

Employment – a wide variety of employment opportunities await you in the business sector such as finance, marketing, e-gaming, retail, HR or law.
