This course forms part of the Level 2 academic pathway.

How will I be assessed?

This course is assessed through a case study based exam worth 50% of the overall mark and a practical element of a coursework project worth 50% of the overall mark.

What are my progression and career options?

Successful completion with satisfactory attendance allows progression to Level 3 study, an apprenticeship or vocational courses. Alternatively, you could seek employment and explore UCM's part-time prospectus for a relevant qualification in your new career.
