- Competency in providing technical support and advice to colleagues in motor vehicle environments.
- Knowledge of providing technical support and advice to colleagues in motor vehicle environments.
- Automotive safety and legal requirements.
- Knowledge in conducting diagnostic consultations with customers in motor vehicle environments.

How will I be assessed?

The assessment format will require the candidate to create a portfolio of work-based evidence and complete short answer questions for each unit.
